AlmaLink

- Presentation Stefan & Daniel on the current progress of the AlmaLink development
- Problems getting the list of all Alumni from the Registrar
- Data statistics could be interesting to show the Alumni
- IDEA: Advertise our services to the non-member Alumni once we have an interesting offering through the list of all former students from the registrar
- AlmaLink will become the base for Alumni Association IT services
- Need to fix Google Login - copying data from the Google Authentication
- Introduce Payment into AlmaLink - needs to happen for Homecoming
- Features for the future: Feature Graphics led to by click bites

- Try to get the class reps and popular people to push people to claim their account
- Need Privacy Policy, Terms of Service on the website
- At the Homecoming: show the reduction in costs from the university hosting us and us hosting us compared to the services we now offer (include Warren costs, mailhost costs)
- At the end (or during Projects), we should come up with a list of learnings for the other board members to use
- Key Milestones should be put into Producteev in order to sync things

Check-in

- 360 Team Feedback
- We want smoother implementation into Producteev of our products

Generation Fund

- Presentation Elena
- Shinta met with Hülsmann at Jacobs -> draft proposal -> current version and design
- Loan: each person gets 9K (3 per year), repays 7% for 5 years after reaching 25K/year
- If we get less people donating this year, the percentage will be readjusted (lower)
- Cap of max repayment: 2 x donated sum = 18K
- If an alumnus is not repaying for 10 years, we need to treat it as a special case
- Generation Fund Committee needs to be elected - should not be too involved in the selection of the student in order to reduce the bottlenecks
- Alumni Ambassadors - students given the scholarship (Generation Fund Scholar) - need to decide on a final name
- Try to involve GF Scholars/Fellow into AlmaLink earlier, keep them close to the Alumni Association
- Ideally have GF Committee a month before Homecoming
- Marketing before GA
- Kickstarter - like system on AlmaLink
- Idea: get in touch with the scholarship awardees, put up profiles on AlmaLink, organize some dinner and ask them to donate

Fee Model

- Presentation Peter
- Alumni Chapter could have their own fees, but we should make sure that paying members also pay for the AA
- Idea: keep the top-tier of the subscriptions at around 200EUR to be easily reduced from tax
- What to call it? "Fees" -> rather "Membership"
- Idea - change the membership **types**: switch all existing free users to different new memberships
- Communication: first starting with the friends of the AFI, then spread slowly, ask for feedback online, integrate, present at the GA
- Provide a lot of information in advance so that people have less to complain about
- No surprise presentation, publish what we have in advance, vote on it before and close at GA

Bank Account

- Online access for Suna and Peter
- Money given to the Alumni Chapters needs to be transferred out of the Alumni Bank Account

Innovation Corner

Brainstorm about potential projects for the future

- Contact Prof. Steven Nay regarding the Design Thinking course in order to work on Alumni Problems and see what they come up with
- Have a list of what is blocking the Alumni Association projects at current time
- Pick up LABS Project - engaging Alumni without giving them official roles
- Alumni should be more involved in gathering funding for students from their companies (3rd party funding) - form an initiative out of this
- Donation packages for companies - jobs posted directly on the internal AlmaLink job posting - Discount for Alumni getting their companies donating
- Open a new track on different ways that we can fundraise for the AA
- Alumni Projects Pipeline page - projects that we do not have the resources to get involved in, but the Alumni can take them up themselves - Idea: use the Google Classroom platform
- Monitoring, evaluating and self-criticising the board
- Formalize the reach-out aspect of our live Board Meetings - meet some influential people, gain some insights
- Alumni Awards - find out if the university still does the awards and try to get them to us
